ORDER FOR ASSIGNMENT TO COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS

On this 8th day of February, 2024, having been convicted of Identity Theft, (Level 8, Non-Person, Non-Drug, Felony), the Defendant is placed on Community Corrections from the sentence of 18 months. Credit is given for 0 day(s) in custody. The assignment is subject to the following conditions:

- WSP 1) Obey all federal, state, and local laws and ordinances;
- WSP 2) Report to your probation officer as directed and obey the officer's lawful orders, including submitting to electronic monitoring at any time as so ordered by your probation officer;
- WSP 3) Permit your probation officer to visit you at home or elsewhere;
- WSP 4) Do not leave the state of Kansas without written authorization from your probation officer;
- WSP 5) Obtain or maintain appropriate, full-time employment or student status (or a combination of both that equals full-time) insofar as possible;
- WSP 6) Keep your probation officer continuously informed of your residence and provide prior notice of change of address;
- WSP 7) Do not serve as an informant or undercover agent for any law enforcement agency without express approval from the Court;
- WSP 8) Do not use alcohol or any illegal drugs. Submit to (and pay for) alcohol and drug testing as directed by your Probation Officer. If a drug or alcohol test is positive or you admit usage, the court may order you, without further hearing, to obtain a substance abuse evaluation and complete all treatment recommendations made by the evaluator;

ADDENDUM TO ORDER FOR ASSIGNMENT TO COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS


