**ORDER DIRECTING PAYMENT OF
ONE-WAY TRAVEL AND LODGING EXPENSES AT GOVERNMENT EXPENSE**


On motion of the defendant, and pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4285, Mr. Cox is required to appear before the United States District Court, District of Wyoming, in which criminal proceedings are pending; the defendant is financially unable to provide the necessary travel expenses to appear before the Court; and the interests of justice are served by this Order.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4285, that the United States Marshal shall provide funds for the defendant for one-way travel and lodging expenses for the defendant to travel from Twin Falls, Idaho to the United States District Court located in Cheyenne, Wyoming to attend the Defendant's change of plea hearing, commencing on December 20, 2023. Such expenses shall be paid by the United States Marshal from funds authorized by the Attorney General for such expenses in the above-captioned matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall extend to reimbursement for any date/time that the above-referenced hearing might be moved to.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that reimbursement for expenses shall be reimbursed at time of hearing.
